Puzzles will be replaced regularly so stop by and see what's new. Everyone is needed to complete the picture of our community. Without you, we can't see the full picture.

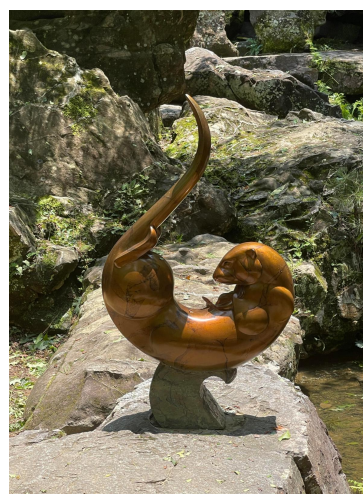
Prayer Team
