**First Sunday Menu is being up-dated!**

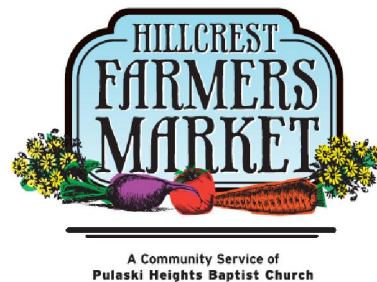

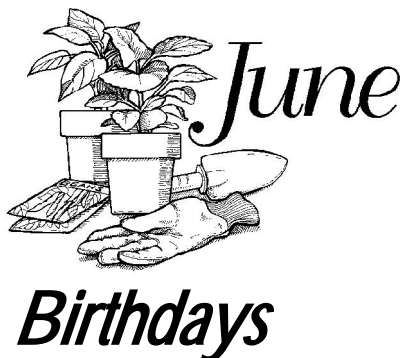
